Rationale

This is a financing scheme whereby the Originator transfers loans receivable held against general debtors (original debtors). The certainty of principal repayment and interest payment as stipulated with respect to the loans made under the commitment line is deemed to be maintained at a level consistent with the A rating through the senior-subordinated structure, setting of cash reserve, etc. and legal measures. Accordingly, JCR has assigned an A rating to the commitment line.
