This is project finance for mega solar project operated by SGET Miyako Mega Solar GK in Usa City, Oita Prefecture. Since review of rating last time, there have been no events that can have any impact on creditworthiness of the beneficial interest/ABL. After start of commercial operation at the end of January 2019, this project has been smoothly implemented. There have been no significant changes to the prospect for future cash flows since JCR initially rated the beneficial interest for the project. Based on these factors, JCR affirmed the A rating on the beneficial interest.
